

### ONITSHA -STREAMS OF LIVING WATERS AT THE NIGER RIVER////







On November 22nd, evangelist Schott arrived at the airport in Asaba, Nigeria. The journey continued by car, across the Niger river into Onitsha. The impressive river runs through five West African countries. It is the third longest stream in Africa and supplies well above 100 million people with water. On this weekend however, other streams were to reach the people of Onitsha – streams of living waters!

Evangelist Schott had been invited by Rev. Egbuona to be one of the guest speakers at the Gospel meeting in Onitsha. Big billboards were announcing the event. The expectations were high, as the evangelist from Germany was about to proclaim the Gospel.

The Word of God sounded powerfully over the PA system, and the distant echo seemed to emphasize the message. Daniel preached a simple and direct sermon on healing. It was a fiery message that was heard, understood, and received. Time and again the crowd shouted, "Hallelujah," as the evangelist pointed his mic at them! The streams of living waters were flowing, and as the Gospel message was coming to an end, there was no need to convince people to act on it. The evangelist counted to three and the people streamed to the stage, to receive forgiveness of their sins. Heaven rejoiced!

A loud and aggressive prayer time followed, as evangelist Schott confronted diseases, curses, and demons, and commanded them to go. God's healing power was released. The visitors were visibly touched and many were healed! Finally, Daniel asked the people to shout out loudly, "Hallelujah," to give God all the glory. Seven mighty Hallelujahs sounded through the night of Onitsha!

Only once a person has heard the saving message – the Gospel – does he or she have a chance to accept it and to receive eternal life. Evangelism is therefore the most important mission Christians have!



# ISOKO – KETTLE DRUMS AND TRUMPETS////











