

Pakistan is mostly being associated with terrorism, the Taliban, or the persecution of Christians. But there are also good news out of that country. Since a few years an unprecedented revival movement is gaining momentum. Many churches have opened up for the move of the Holy Spirit and are active, despite oppositions. The ministry of Pastor Anwar Fazal is outstanding and effective. It is the biggest evangelistic ministry in Pakistan, with a strong healing anointing.

GEN had the privilege to hold a Gospel Meeting in cooperation with this ministry. It took place in Sialkot from the 16th - 18th of October. This Gospel Meting was historic for the city of Sialkot. More than 100,000 people came to the meetings each of the three nights. The roads were blocked for hours due to the heavy traffic. But the move of God could not be stopped.


The spiritual hunger of the people was outstanding. People came with great expectations and were not disappointed. Evangelist Schott preached on two nights. GEN conducted a Gospel Meeting in cooperation with at church in Nyamata (Rwanda), as announced in the previous newsletter. The Gospel message touched the people of the city, severely affected by the genocide. 465 decisions for Jesus were counted during the two days of Gospel Meetings. Hallelujah!

Many people were healed. One testimony was especially touching: A young lady testified in tears that Jesus healed her eye.

A young girl experienced God's favor in an extraordinary way. She had been bewitched as a child and could not open her hands and was hearing impaired. Jesus broke the power of darkness and healed her. Yet she still had problems with her legs. After receiving prayer on the stage even her legs were healed.

Prayer warriors in Germany, as well as 50 more prayer warriors on location were active, before and during the Gospel Meetings. This must have been the reason why it did not rain

during the open air meetings in Nyamata - while it was raining elsewhere.

After the work was done, there were more than enough reasons to celebrate the Lord. The praise and worship continued until into the night, accompanied by joyful dancing on the dusty ground. What a glorious sight! Heaven rejoiced, as a pillar of whirled-up dust was rising. Thank you Jesus!
