THE RETURN OF THE GOSPEL - BURSA, ETHIOPIA ////

From November 21–24, GEN held a large evangelistic crusade in Bursa, located in the Sidama region of Ethiopia. The journey from Addis Ababa was long. Eventually, the minibus left the paved road, and the final stretch became an adventure. Recent rains had left deep mud, making the road nearly impassable. The driver had to assess the road conditions repeatedly to decide whether or how to proceed. Some team members helped by preparing the path and guiding the minibus through tricky sections. The local coordinator met the incoming team several kilometers out and, along with some helpers, had repaired a particularly difficult part of the road. They made it directly to the event site—a large field on a hillside in the center of the village of Bursa. Despite the rain and the soggy ground, visitors were already waiting for the evangelist.

Because of the precarious weather, Daniel preached a very short but impactful message. As the rain began to fall, the visitors repeated the sinner's prayer. Once the rain eased, brothers from the church helped carry the suitcases that were in the minibus. Together, the group walked to their accommodation—trudging across the muddy field and up the hill. The condition of the road, which had to be used repeatedly in the coming days, was beyond words.

Despite the challenging conditions—issues like water, electricity, and hygiene—the people demonstrated remarkable hospitality. A charcoal fire was lit in the living room to warm the space. By adding a special type of wood, the room was repeatedly smoked over the following days, a traditional practice to repel insects.

On the second day, the approaching rain once again forced the evangelist to shorten his message. Nevertheless, people flocked to the stage to receive forgiveness of sins. After the sinner's prayer, Daniel asked those who were accepting Christ for the first time to raise their hands. Hundreds responded. To avoid any misunderstanding, he asked the question again, and again, hundreds raised their hands. The evangelist then prayed for healing, and that evening, the Lord healed over 150 people. Numerous amazing testimonies followed, including healings of long-standing illnesses like cancer, heart conditions, and kidney problems. The crowd erupted in praise, with Hallelujahs ringing out repeatedly. This continued on each of the following days.



















Sunday marked the highlight of the Gospel meeting. Under sunny skies, tens of thousands gathered on the field for a joint open-air service. Over 200 singers, dressed in vibrant choir robes, processed through the town to escort the evangelist from his accommodation. The procession moved with songs and the sound of horns until they reached the field, where the crowd was already waiting for the evangelist.

Daniel preached on revival, calling attendees to repentance. Thousands streamed to the altar to receive forgiveness of sins. Finally, Daniel invited the pastors onto the stage to pray for revival in Bursa. The crowd was deeply moved, leaving some in tears.

During the second part of the open-air service, the evangelist prayed for healing, and this time, about 200 people were healed. One especially remarkable healing involved a man who, for four years, had only been able to move with the help of a long stick. Supporting himself at the top, he would struggle to drag his leg behind him. Eight days before the event, his condition had worsened; he became bedridden and had to be carried to the crusade. But that afternoon, the Lord healed him. Beaming with joy, he came onto the stage to share his testimony, jumping and rejoicing. When the evangelist broke the man's stick into pieces, the crowd erupted in jubilant celebration!

The four days in remote Bursa were a festival of joy! The local pastors were grateful that, after 14 years, the Gospel had returned to them. Several thousand visitors received forgiveness of sins. Hundreds were healed. The surroundings were filled with Hallelujah shouts. Bursa was forever changed!
