Even in the church services many miracles happened and long-term diseases were healed. Amongst others a woman was healed from tumors in the neck and belly. Another lady who had had cancer, had been operated 30 years ago. Much tissue had been removed and her neck was harmed. She had her head tilted to one side, since. Jesus healed her! After 30 years of suffering, she was able to straighten her neck again. Hallelujah!

On the last evening of the mission trip to India Evangelist Schott preached in a traditional Indian church. A powerful time of prayer followed. Evangelist Schott was asked to pray for each and everyone with the laying on of hands, which took quite a while. Miracles happened and people were filled with the Holy Spirit.

Weeks later we learned that the church service that night caused a revival in the church. It was their first experience of that kind with the Holy Spirit – like a Pentecost just for that church. Now the Christians are attending the church again and more healing testimonies of that particular service followed. Thank you Jesus!

Our coworker in India had done a great job and the events were well prepared. As it turned out, even the spiritual world was prepared. With authority? Yes, because it is the message


of our king.

Effective?


