THE FULL GOSPEL TO THE WHOLE WORLD!

PAKISTAN – WHEN A DOOR CLOSES ////

After many obstacles, Evangelist Daniel Schott was finally able to enter Pakistan on October 8. That very evening, he preached at the weekly prayer meeting of the *Eternal Life Church* in Lahore, attended by several thousand people and broadcast live. The Lord was already moving: people were saved, experienced forgiveness of sins, and received healing. Afterward, several people came on stage to share the miracles the Lord had done in their lives that night.

A Gospel crusade had been organized in Okara for Friday. The local team had been working with great expectation toward the event. But things took an unexpected turn, and the door for the Gospel began to close. Certain events in Pakistan and abroad stirred radical Islamic groups to take to the streets. Violence erupted in Lahore, with all the tragic consequences that such unrest brings. Because of the tense situation, the team's departure from Lahore was moved up so they could leave the city in time. In addition, the team had to take an alternative route to Okara. Escorted by police and security forces, the team made its way toward the destination with sirens wailing and horns blaring when needed.





The government had declared a state of emergency that Friday. In Lahore and other cities, schools and universities were ordered to close, and a ban on public gatherings was issued. As a result, the Gospel crusade was at risk of being shut down. Despite immense pressure, this could still be prevented. However, many of the buses bringing people to the event were stopped by police and forced to turn back.

The team from Lahore, including the German evangelist, was warmly welcomed in Okara. Pastor Anwar Fazal greeted Daniel and handed him the microphone. At once, a mighty "Hallelujah!" thundered from his mouth. Yet many of the visitors seemed burdened — no surprise, given the tense situation. It was clear: this would not be an easy task.

Daniel preached a message of grace and healing, urging the people to believe that God truly desires to save and heal them. At the end of the message, thousands raised their hands to pray for forgiveness of sins. For many, it was their first time. It was a holy moment.

Then, with a loud and fiery voice, the evangelist confronted sickness, pain, demons, and curses in the mighty name of Jesus. Again





and again, his words echoed across the field: "In the name of Jesus!" The crowd stretched their hands toward heaven to receive their healing. Finally, the evangelist urged the people to check their healings, and soon the field was filled with movement. Hundreds raised their hands to testify to their healing.

Moving testimonies followed on stage: people shared how they had been healed from long-term illnesses. Again and again, Daniel asked, "Who healed you?" and the answer resounded: "Jesus Christ!" To conclude, Daniel stirred the crowd, and seven loud "Hallelujahs" thundered into the night sky over Okara.

At last, the team headed back to Lahore under police escort. The mission was accomplished — the Gospel had been proclaimed once more! Yet how soon it will be possible again remains uncertain, as the very next day the authorities revoked the permit for another upcoming Gospel crusade.

The door for the Gospel was beginning to close. But just in time, the people of Okara, and many others online, heard the message of salvation. Thank you, Jesus!

After an eventful journey, I have safely returned from Pakistan and want to sincerely thank each of you for your faithful support of the Gospel crusade in Okara.

Due to severe unrest in the country and the declared state of emergency, far fewer people were able to attend than originally expected, but the Lord's work continued powerfully nonetheless.

Despite all targeted attacks and the cunning strategies of the enemy, the Gospel was proclaimed with great impact. People came to Jesus Christ, hearts were touched, and the sick received healing.

The political situation in Pakistan and throughout the region is currently very concerning, and it is uncertain when such a Gospel crusade will be possible again. All the more grateful I am that we were able to step through "the open door" just in time:

I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. (Revelation 3:8)

Just as the church in Philadelphia in the Book of Revelation was given "a little open door," so a door was also opened for us. And we walked through it. We at GEN remain committed to faithfully preserving the Word of God — the Gospel — and fearlessly proclaiming the name that is above every name: Jesus!

Thank you for your faithful partnership and your heart for taking the Gospel to the nations! Please continue to stand with us so that together we can proclaim the Gospel in all its fullness around the world.
