ANGOLA - A NEW DOOR OPENS!////

What a warm welcome at the airport in Luena, the provincial capital of Moxico,

Angola. Women are singing and the pastors other officials and standing in row, form the welcoming committee. In Angola protocol is highly valued. Bishop Chimondi, the host, introduces the people and Evangelist Schott greets everyone individually. A woman rushes in and wipes the shoes of the bishop and the evangelist. To Europeans that may seem strange, but that is a symbolic act in accordance with the Angolan culture. A reporter is filming the whole event.

After a short stop at the hotel, the group sets off to the governor's residence. The streets in Luena are dusty but rather wide. Some of the streets downtown are seamed with thick-trunked trees. There is not much traffic and soon the off-roader approaches the elegant government building. Since the governor is absent, the meeting must be postponed. The group makes use of their time, visiting the peace monument in Luena. Some interviews are taken with the evangelist and the

evangelist and the pastors. On April 4th, 2002 a peace treaty was signed in Luena, ending the Angolan civil war that lasted for 27 years.

> That event was marked by erecting a 30 meters high monument, made of iron and copper – a peace dove on top of two open hands.

It is certainly no coincidence that the work of GEN starts in no other city but Luena. It is the city of peace for the whole country. Like the political peace, so the peace of the Gospel must spread throughout the 18 provinces of Angola. It has started in Luena this weekend.

In the afternoon the governor is still not around. The vice-governor makes himself available and receives the delegation in a large meeting room. Pleasantries are exchanged, followed by short discussions. Evangelist Schott explains the reason for the visit and calls attention to the work the Pentecostal free churches are doing. In Angola more than 40 percent of the people are Catholic. Schott explains that although the government has the political power, the Christians have the power of the

> Gospel. People who are changed by the Gospel would also change the country

for the better. The vice-governor seems open and refers to the existing religious freedom in Angola. A consultant and the head of the culture department are also present and show interest in the evangelistic work in Luena. The city is open for the Gospel!

The next few days fly by quickly. Leaders of the Assemblies of God from various regions in Angola have arrived to attend the conference and the Gospel Meetings in the evenings. They are hungry for the Word of God.



In the evenings, Evangelist Schott preaches the Gospel in the power of the Holy Spirit. The Evangelist is welcomed warmly. The scene somewhat resembles the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. Cloths are spread out on the ground and noise is made to welcome the guest. The atmosphere is charged with joyful expectation. The Holy Spirit moves through the preached Word and the following prayers. People are saved and delivered from demonic powers. More than 300 persons are healed this weekend. The healing testimonies are remarkable. People with extended illnesses of seven and even 20 years are healed. Jesus heals!

There are many challenges this weekend, also due to the language barriers. In Angola Portuguese is spoken, and the interpreters oftentimes have only a limited knowledge of English. At times Daniel is even translated into two languages. But what counts at the end is that people are saved, healed, and delivered! Even though the visit to Angola is short, it has a great impact. Even the national television reports what is happening in Luena, this weekend. In addition, Evangelist Schott is able to have an insight into the excellent organization of the Assemblies of God in Angola. Additional possibilities for Gospel Meetings and conferences are considered for the future.

The spiritual hunger of the Angolan Christians becomes evident once again on the morning of the departure. A delegation of pastors comes to pick up the evangelist from the hotel, early in the morning. Even there in the lobby of the hotel, some pastors kneel down to be prayed for again. What a hunger for the anointing and for the Holy Spirit!

Similarly, I am in awe again and again when God heals people. Still yesterday, a sister from Essen (Germany) testified that she had been healed after ten years of suffering.

But it is even the little stories, happening on the sidelines that touch me. One of these "little" stories, I would like to tell you here briefly:

While I was in Angola in July, Apostle Kakoma from Zambia came and joined our meetings. He was the one who connected me to the bishop, and it was a joy to meet him there again. The joy became even greater when he shared a testimony of what happened in Zambia after I had left.

Apostle Kakoma told that when I was preaching in Zambia, I proclaimed that the Lord would restore what the devil had stolen. To him these words became prophetic, and he took them personally. At that time I couldn't have guessed that God would use that one sentence to work a miracle. Shortly before I came to Zambia in April, the apostle's car had been stolen. When Kakoma heard that sentence at the Gospel Meeting, he clung to the promise. A few days later his phone rang. An unknown voice asked to meet with him. How that person got his phone number remains a mystery.

Soon several men came to the appointment. They were the thieves, and they brought back the car of the apostle. It may be a "little" story, but with a great meaning to the affected person. God stands by His word!

Over the years, I have learned not to underestimate the power of words. Sometimes, at first glance it seems that hardly anything is happening. Then one has to continue praying by faith. But once the testimonies are being shared, after the ministration time, the joy is great over the mighty move of the Lord. And sometimes years go by before one hears a testimony of what God did through the preaching and prayers. He is a wonder-working God, and He is faithful!
